Participation Agreement

Article 1 (Purpose)

Tokyo International Projection Mapping Award Executive Committee (hereinafter referred to as “TIPMA”) requests that those incorporated educational institutions (hereinafter referred to as “the School(s)”, that plan to participate in the “Tokyo International Projection Mapping Awards Vol.5” to be organized by TIPMA(hereinafter referred to as “the Event”) planned for November 2020 at Tokyo Big Sight, who have completed, signed and sealed the designated pledge form, that as regards the images to be screened at the Event (hereinafter referred to as “the Work(s)”) perform planning, production, editing image quality adjustment and all other duties related to production of the Work (hereinafter collectively referred to as “the Duties”). The School(s) including their faculty members, students, etc. shall by October 31, 2020 completely perform the Duties for which they are responsible and submit the Work in accordance with the conditions stated in the official website “Application Outline”

Article 2 (Vesting of Rights, etc.)

Important items including the vesting of rights are as stated in the official website “Application Outline”.

Article 3 (Consideration, Recompense)

As regards the Works, the total amount of consideration, recompense payable by TIPMA shall be limited to the prize money given to the Schools who receive an award at the Event. Further where in the performance of the Duties a third party (including but not limited to the faculty members or students) has provided funding, etc. and that third party has made a claim for recompense, the concerned School shall directly make payment to that third party.

Article 4 (Agreement Enforcement Area and Period)

This participation agreement is enforceable throughout the world, including Japan, and the enforcement period, unless separately set forth, shall come into force and effect from the date this participation agreement has been entered into and remain in force and effect for one (1) year from the day following the date upon

which the Event was held.

Article 5 (Guarantees)

TIPMA and the Schools do hereby guarantee that they possess all of the rights, authorities and capacities required for entry into and the ongoing performance of this participation agreement and further that they are able to execute this participation agreement freely and effectively without being bound to any third party or the subject of an objection made by a third party.

Article 6 (Prohibition against Transfer of Rights)

TIPMA and the Schools, unless separately set forth within this participation agreement, in respect of all or any rights or obligations arising under this participation agreement, shall not without the prior consent in writing of the other party transfer, allow to pass by way succession or offer as security any of these rights or obligations.

Article 7 (Credit Titles, etc.)

Within the credit titles for the Works, the following shall appear.

Article 8 (Maintenance of Confidentiality)

TIPMA and the Schools in the performance or execution of this participation agreement shall not without the prior consent in writing of the other party disclose or cause to be disclosed the confidential information obtained from the other party, or the other party’s trading partners, affiliates, etc.

Article 9 (Compensation for Damages, etc.)

Where any School, from the perspective of an impartial bystander, would be deemed to be in breach of all or any part of this participation agreement (including the Application Outline), TIPMA may in addition to cancelling the application for the Work as submitted by the concerned School, in the event that TIPMA has suffered damages, may also make a claim for compensation for damages against that School.

Article 10 (Separate Consultations)

Where any matter not set forth in this participation agreement arises or there is any uncertainty concerning the interpretation of this participation agreement, this shall be determined based upon good faith consultations between TIPMA and the concerned School.

Article 11 (Consent to Jurisdiction)

In the event that any dispute arises between the parties in respect of this participation agreement, TIPMA and the concerned School do hereby consent to the Tokyo District Court as being the court of primary and exclusive jurisdiction
